Subject:- Grant of Extended Permission to Anand Charitable trust's, Anand Ayurved College Phulewadi Road, Vijapur, Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar - 423701, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0522) with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2026-27-reg.

Sir/Madam,

- 1) To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely to Anand Charitable trust's, Anand Ayurved College Phulewadi Road, Vijapur, Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar - 423701, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0522) inspection was conducted on 14.05.2026 and 15.05.2026 on Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the extended permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2026-27.
- 2) The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations thereunder
- 3) Accordingly, the assessment report was duly placed in the 165th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 24.07.2026 and Board concluded that the college is fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations but fulfilling the criteria for issuance of Extended. Hence, the Board decided to issue extended permission in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2026-27 as the college has been permitted consecutively for previous three years after fulfilling the conditions as specified in the concerned Regulations.

"DECISION"

- 4) Therefore, Extended permission is hereby granted to Anand Ayurved College Phulewadi Road, Vijapur, Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar - 423701, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0522) in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2026-27
- 5) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 6) Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.
- 7) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 8) Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. Ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.
- 9) The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2026 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2027-2028:-
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled,

- ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024,
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
- 10) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2027-2028.

Note: -It is also noted that, if the concerned University does not grant affiliation to the college or withdraws the affiliation, the permission granted by MARBISM shall automatically stand withdrawn without any further notice or order.
